Notes:

- The Institute shall ensure 500 hours of teaching per semester. It required the deans/principals shall arrange extra classes, or remedial teaching.
- The Institute should ensure that at least two class test are conducted after completing 50% & 100% syllabus respectively. An students will be required to appear in both test and internal class tests. If for any reason (except the consent of students) test or theory, paper, consistent in nature, the students fail to appear in any test, it will be responsibility of Professor/Teacher or Institute to arrange class test for such students. However, if the student fails to appear in the class test, the class test will be conducted before starting class test and in case of second class test at least one month before the start of any semester theory examination. The number of class test and internal test held for each class test, 10% attendance in 1st test and 75% attendance of second class test are required. In case attendance is short, students can be informed accordingly or remedial tests.
- The Deans/Principal of Institute shall submit attendance of students regularly through attendance monitoring system of the university and shall ensure that no student is allowed to appear in the examinations who has not attended the required minimum attendance as per terms prescribed in relevant ordinances. It will be obligatory on the part of Deans/Principal of Institute to send merit students and their award cards will not be issued to them. A list of students detained from appearing a University Examination will be submitted to University and their Examination centre before commencement of their examinations.
- The teacher who is assigned evaluation duty during semester shall be entitled for earned leave as per rules and duly return by their examination work.
- The admission programme for 1st year B.Tech. studies shall be between July 01, 2019 to Aug. 31, 2019.
- Summer Training Internship for 1st year B.Tech. students shall also be held between June 01, 2020 to July 30, 2020.
