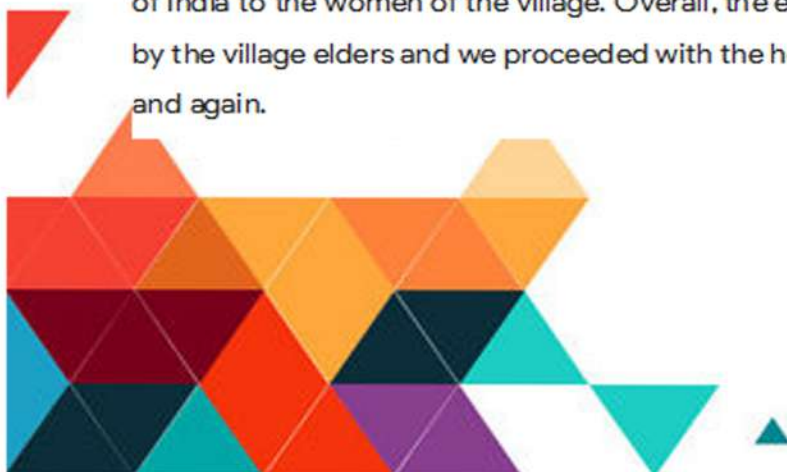
# Workshop on Women Empowerment and Digital Awareness Cont.
