
- 1. The minimum number for student participation is 30 from each Institute.

- 4. By using these pictures you all can either create your own media link or use GLBITM media link (will be shared later) for report submission at IIC portal.



In this session, he talked about the basic concepts behind identifying any problem and taking it to its final and feasible solution with the help of various practical examples seen in daily life. He emphasised on letting the idea to be matured first and then take it

for any funding or pitching phase. Also, he explained various risks and solutions included in any idea generation process by giving different example.

The event was very informative and about 250 students and faculties from the 5 mentee institutes (Babu Banarasi Das Institute of Technology and Management, Delhi Institute of Advanced Studies, Jaipuria Institute of Management, Krishna Engineering College and Kunwar Satyavira College of Engineering and Management) were benefitted by this online session.
