- **4.** To promote students towards Industry Exposure Learning.



The speaker of the session was Prof Manoj Kumar Mishra. Prof Manoj Kumar Mishra is a well-known academician and researcher. He has 20 years of versatile experience of teaching, research and administration in India and abroad in the capacities of Dean, Director, Vice President and Professor. At present he is Professor, College of Business and Economics, Salale University Fitche, Ethiopia. He is also Secretary of Forum for Interdisciplinary Research Methods, an international association of Research Methods professionals.

He talks about Employment in terms of Entrepreneurship and Development. Prof Manoj explained Employment is all about getting a job or searching for a job. Employability refers to a person's capability of gaining initial employment. This capability is about having an effective mix of knowledge, skills and personal attitudes in order to be employed initially and function successfully in the required roles. He explained employability depends on knowledge, skills and attitude. Management is very important. He also talked about governmental projects and motivated students that the Indian government has launched very ambitious projects like Make in India, Digital India, Startup action plans, etc. These projects require leaders with advanced knowledge in engineering, technology, commerce and industry.
